A historical province which as far as is known was mentioned for the first time in the Chronicle of 'Amda Tseyon and for the last time in the Chronicle of Ba'eda Maryam. In a list clearly grouped geographically it is placed between Angot and Enderta. The province of Qeda may have had Bugna on its west and the Danakil plains to the east. The documentary evidence suggests that in fact Qeda became the province later known as Doba /circa JDH24 09°/41° on British War Office map/.

Missionary Elsa once witnessed that they made an ox swim between the island and the shore by having it tied to a reed canoe on each side. There was an Orthodox Christian church on the island. A Laqi boy Zeoge from the island had been one of Elsa's best pupils in her school. There was a village with partly decrepit and partly newer houses. It seemed to be a custom not to repare huts but to build a new one when necessary. The Laqi houses were built of stone.
